*Pre-registered voters are required to provide an approved form of identification at the polling place before receiving and casting as regular ballot. Voters who are not pre-registered such as voters registering to vote on election day - and voters changing precincts must also provide proof of residence. A voter who is unable to provide an approved form of identification (or prove residence if required) 1) may have the voter's identity/residence attested to by another registered voter in the precinct 2) prove identity and residence using Election Day Registration documents, or 3) cast a provisional ballot and provide proof of identity/residence at the county auditor's office by noon on Monday, October 9th. Election Day Registrant attestors must provide an approved form of identification. 4PM on Monday, October 2<sup>nd</sup> deadline to vote absentee in person at the Auditor's Office.
